1. Acquisition

Peak has acquired Mojungle Inc., a mobile content sharing technology developer, with plans to incorporate Mojungle’s mobile device technology capabilities with Peak and Envision solutions. Initial plans are to incorporate these technologies as web services, which will enable customers to dynamically share, distribute, and link messages, photographs, and videos as part of their underwriting and claims processes. These new mobile content features are scheduled to be integrated into our product line by late 2007.

2. Envision – Update

The Envision Salt Lake City operations have been consolidated into the Columbus, Ohio office. Envision retains key staff while expanding the support staff to move the suite of products forward. The Ohio data center is operational with plans to move the Salt Lake City ASP services from Consonus to Peak’s SAS 70 facility. Disaster recovery services and hot site services were implemented during the quarter for both Peak and Envision customers.

3. Florida Mandates Electronic Reporting

Florida Division of Workers’ Compensation (DWC) has adopted Rule 69L-56 F.A.C., effective January 7, 2007 that **mandates electronic reporting of First Reports of Injury (FROI) and Subsequent Reports (SROI)**, which correspond to the DWC-1, 12 & 13.

FL Insurers will be required to file Claims forms electronically, and will be grouped by Insurer Code # in one of three “test to production” phases beginning November 1, 2007.

The rule also requires current EDI trading partners, who have been voluntarily using Release 1 for Claims, to begin testing the new R3 EDI standard beginning November 1, 2007.
